

Reports in Power BI

Power BI Report: A multi-page, interactive Power BI output that supports filters, slicers, drill-through, and navigation, designed for detailed data exploration.

Dashboard: A single-view canvas in Power BI Service composed of pinned visuals, providing a high-level overview of key business metrics.

Paginated Report: A pixel-perfect, print-optimized report created in Power BI Report Builder, capable of rendering large tables across multiple printed pages.

Bookmark: A saved state of a report page in Power BI, capturing the current filter selections, slicer values, visual visibility, and sort order.

Button: An interactive element in a Power BI report that triggers an action such as page navigation, bookmark selection, or URL launch.

Page Navigator: A built-in Power BI control that automatically generates a navigation panel synchronized with the report's pages or bookmarks.

Drill-through: A report interaction that navigates the user to a detail page pre-filtered to the context of a selected data point.

Tooltip Page: A hidden report page configured to display as a hover tooltip when a user pauses over a visual, providing additional context.

Theme: A set of formatting defaults applied globally across all visuals in a Power BI report, controlling colors, fonts, and visual styles.

Slicer: A visual element in Power BI that allows users to interactively filter report data by selecting one or more values.

Q&A: A Power BI feature that allows users to type natural language questions about their data and receive automatically generated visual answers.

Cross-filtering: The automatic filtering of data in one visual based on a selection made in another visual on the same report page.

Conditional Formatting: A Power BI feature that dynamically changes the color, icons, or data bars of a field based on underlying data values.

Power BI Report Builder: A standalone tool for designing paginated reports for Power BI, based on the SQL Server Reporting Services authoring environment.

Drill-down: A navigation action within a single visual that moves to a finer level of detail within an established hierarchy.
