

# Deploying and Maintaining Assets in Power BI

**Workspace:** A shared environment in Power BI Service where teams create, organize, and distribute dashboards, reports, datasets, and paginated reports.

**Admin Role:** The highest workspace role in Power BI, with full permissions to manage all workspace settings, members, and content.

**Member Role:** A workspace role that can publish and manage apps, edit content, and add users at the Member level or below, but cannot update workspace settings or add new admins.

**Contributor Role:** A workspace role that can create, edit, and delete content within the workspace but cannot manage app publishing or workspace membership.

**Viewer Role:** A workspace role with read-only access to reports and dashboards, with no ability to create or modify content.

**Organizational App:** A Power BI app that bundles reports, dashboards, and datasets for distribution to users within the same organization.

**Template App:** A Power BI app designed for external distribution that allows recipients to connect their own data to a pre-built report and dashboard structure.

**Read Permission:** A dataset access level that allows a user to view reports built on the dataset but not create new content or query the dataset via API.

**Build Permission:** A dataset access level that allows a user to create new reports and other content from the dataset and discover it through search.

**Write Permission:** A dataset access level that allows a user to view and edit dataset metadata and grant Read, Build, or Reshare permissions to other users.

**Reshare Permission:** A dataset access level that allows a user to share dataset access with additional users or groups.

**Row-Level Security (RLS):** A security feature that restricts which rows a user can see in a report, defined using DAX filter rules in Power BI Desktop and assigned in Power BI Service.

**Sensitivity Label:** A data classification tag applied to Power BI content that enforces organizational data protection policies such as encryption and export restrictions.

**Promoted Content:** Power BI content highlighted by an owner or workspace member as valuable and worth sharing, representing the first tier of content endorsement.

**Certified Content:** Power BI content formally validated by a designated organizational group as reliable and authoritative for broad use.

**Report Subscription:** A scheduled email that delivers a snapshot of a Power BI report to specified recipients at a defined frequency.

**Data Alert:** A notification triggered in Power BI Service when a KPI, card, or gauge visual exceeds a defined threshold following a data refresh.

**Pro License:** A Power BI per-user license required to create, publish, and share most Power BI content in shared workspaces.
